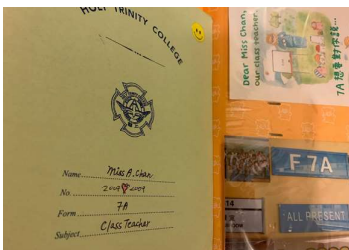

Miss Chan一直在上智任教地理科，走過會考、高考到現在文憑試年代，也曾當高考班的班主任。初入職時，她當學生像妹妹般看待，後來年紀漸長，她就將學生當女兒般呵護，覺得她們很可愛。在她任教早年時期，曾有學生分別患紅斑狼瘡和骨癌離世，Miss Chan感到非常惋惜：學生這麼年青便與世長辭——她常常勸勉自己和學生都要珍惜青春，活好每分每秒。

Miss Chan當了近二十年的升學及事業輔導主任，與學生談升學選科時總是循循善誘。當她遇到一些學生選大學，只想選三大時，她會說「可能城大、理大等其他大學都想取錄你，你為何不給他們一個機會呢？」又有些學生不明社會現況：想讀社會科學系，又擔心這是「乞食科」，又或者有學生不設實際，只想報讀一些「既輕鬆但又可賺大錢」的學科，她會耐心向學生分析實際情況，讓學生作出最適合她們的選擇。總的來說，Miss Chan心目中上智學生大部分都自發性高，成績優異，為人謙虛，有責任心，兼備內在美與外在美。有些時候，畢業生回來探老師，看到她們學業、事業有成，散發着自信的光芒，教她印象深刻。「能夠見到學生青出於藍，就是老師最大的回報」這是她的心底話。

Miss Chan認為「生命不在乎長久，但在乎是否精彩」。今天還年輕的她要退下教育火線，享受嚮往已久的精彩生活去，在很多人看來是多麼浪漫的決定。但人生充滿可能性，尤其在瞬息萬變的香港，Miss Chan「珍惜青春，活在當下」的態度，未嘗不是一種可取的安身立命之道。

Memorable HTC Annual Dinner, 2019 by Mr. Edward Chan

I am honoured to have been invited to participate in HTCPSA Annual Dinner held on Saturday, 27th April, 2019.

I was in seventh heaven when I knew that the venue was Lucky Dragon Restaurant. It is situated at Woh Chai Street and the nearest Chinese restaurant to HTC, the school which I had taught for thirty-three years.

There were two restaurants which my male colleagues and I used to go having lunch. One of them was the present-day "Popeye" fast food shop where we had western food, also located at Woh Chai Street; the other was Lucky Dragon Restaurant where we had Chinese food.

My sweet memories were brought back when the name was mentioned again.

More than twenty years ago, a large group of around ten male colleagues and I used to enjoy our lunch here, having Chinese food including dim sum and delicious popular dishes like Duo Style Fried Rice, Stir-fried Beef Noodles, boiled noodles with pork, etc.

While the female teachers preferred to bring lunch boxes, we liked to eat out as we wanted to have some relaxation from our stressful teaching by having a chat together, with topics ranging from stock market to some political issues.

The restaurant comprises two storeys with big round tables and small square tables which can accommodate both small groups of customers as well as small ones. Besides, the upper floor is so specially designed that it can be used as a ballroom in the evening because it possesses a spacious dance floor. I knew that one of my colleagues used to go there to practise Latin dancing like Cha Cha as a kind of entertainment at night.

When compared with the Annual Dinner last year, the number of participants was a great deal less since celebration for the retirement of the previous principal was held at the same time in the last occasion. There were only eight

tables and the participants were approximately one hundred while there were more than fifty tables last year. However, it was as full of life as the previous time. The atmosphere, I think, was among one of the best of this function which I had attended before. One of the features of Annual Dinner this year was it was held in a peculiar and relaxing way.

The arrival time was 6:30 pm. When I reached the venue punctually and climbed up the stairs to the second floor, unlike the previous Annual Dinner, I found that even though the dining tables had been prepared, they were set around the dance floor. Instead of sitting formally around the tables like the past, some participants had already practised dancing on the dance floor energetically. Besides, there was a flamboyantly dressed Trinitian called Christine who served as the temporary instructor demonstrating to other Trinitians some easy dance steps and the latter followed suit.

The dress code of the Annual Dinner was known as "Blink Blink", a curious title. To the best of my understanding, it meant "modern, colourful and gorgeous" type of clothing. Other than this, a contest called "Blink Blink Competition" was held. The participant whose clothing was the most eye-catching would become the winner. Christine, the skilful dance instructor, was announced to be the winner afterwards.

The leading roles of the dinner party, of course, were played by the two Mistresses of Ceremony, Catherine and Veronica. They were fit for the theme of this function not just because of their effective communication with the participants but because of their attractive outlook. The hairstyle, make-up and dress worn by Catherine were extremely modern, which could be compared with those popular stars of the entertainment business. Besides, I was particularly impressed by the attractive cute "little hat" worn by Veronica.

After the welcome speech made by the new principal, the dinner started at 7:30 pm. Traditional dishes like steamed fish, roasted chicken, mushroom with vegetable were served according to a set menu. Even though the quality of the food was just on the average, we put more stress on exchanging recent information among one another while eating.

Then, lucky draw brought excitement to the participants as everyone looked forward to becoming the winner. Besides, the presenters were their beloved teachers who taught them in the past, so lucky winners were happy to receive prizes from them.

The highlight of the dinner programme was the singing of the school song. It made participants reminisce the old times. The first verse "Happy we in love united, Of the Holy Trinity" reminded singers the importance of both "love" and "unity" and nurtured them a strong sense of belonging. Everyone was so eager to sing this song again as a feeling of satisfaction was shown on their face when the Mistress of Ceremony invited them to do so.

Photo-taking is a routine of our everyday life, so normally there is no sense of surprise in this activity. However, in the dinner gathering, it was exceptionally hilarious as it included all members of the party - present and past Supervisors, present Principal and teachers, retired teachers and Trinitians were included. Interesting poses suggested for taking different photographs caused thrills and spills as well as sudden outburst of laughter.

Jon Hurwitz, an American screenwriter, mentions, "That's the fun of going to a high school reunion: it's seeing the people who you were close to all those years ago, and re-exploring the relationships of the past."

Teenage is a very important of growth in our life. Peer group relationship in school is the most precious. Even though it ends after graduation, functions like annual dinner can help to prolong and strengthen it.

Tim McGraw, an entertainer says, "We all take different paths in life, but no matter where we go, we take a little of each other everywhere."

Graduates have been engaged in different professions after they graduate. They go along different paths, so they can share their valuable experiences with their counterparts when they meet. Indeed, they can have more useful mutual support in society if they communicate frequently with one another.

I know that many Trinitians have gatherings with others who graduated from HTC in the same year. Unlike them, HTCPSA Annual Dinner is a formal gathering with the presence of graduates from different generations. It looks like a big family gathering when they meet.

I sincerely hope every graduate will consider to spare a night to join this meaningful activity in the near future even though they are occupied with so many things related to their work and family. I believe it is worth their effort to return to the warm embrace of her mother school for a while again.
